

SAFE LOCKER ROOMS HAVE RULES

Men's and Women's Adult Locker Rooms are provided for use by adults age 19 or older only. For the respect and comfort of all members, children under age 19 are not permitted in the adult locker rooms at any time, including infants. Adults with children should use the appropriate child-friendly locker rooms, or family changing rooms.

The Women and Girl's Locker Room is provided for use by all women and girls and boys under the age of six escorted by a female parent or guardian.

The Men and Boy's Locker Room is provided for use by all men and boys and girls under the age of six escorted by a male parent or guardian.

The Family and Accessible Changing rooms are provided for use for those with special needs, by a parent or guardian escorting children of the opposite gender over the age of five, those with individual needs of any kind, or those who wish for more privacy. Adults accompanying children under age six may use the appropriate adult and child locker room.

- No cell phone, camera or video equipment of any kind is to be used in the locker rooms.
- Food or drink of any kind is prohibited in the locker rooms. Plastic water bottles are permitted. No glass of any kind.
- Bare feet and wet swimsuits are not allowed outside of the locker rooms or pool area.
- Use a towel to dry off after pool and shower use to prevent slips and falls.
- Keep our facility clean by not spitting or urinating in the shower and remove hair from the drain after use.
- Please respect the privacy of others while in the locker room.
- Do not leave your belongings in the changing areas or rooms.
- The swimsuit dryer is intended to dry swimsuits only. Do not put any other type of garment in the dryer.
- Pick-up area after use and dispose of trash in garbage or recycling bins.
- The Y is not responsible for personal property that has been lost, damaged or stolen. Please lock your belongings in a locker. Locks are available at the Member Service Center.
- Lockers are for daily use and must be emptied before leaving the facility. No locks are to be left on overnight.
- Loitering is not permitted in the locker room at any time.
- Report any issues immediately and directly to a YMCA staff member.
- Members and guests are required to follow the YMCA Code of Conduct posted in the lobby.
